

기업과 인권 (Business and Human Rights) 분과세션

Respecting and supporting human rights remains one of the most challenging areas of corporate sustainability. As following the endorsement of the Guiding Principles on Business and Human Rights by the Human Rights Council in 2011, more businesses are coming to realize their legal, moral and commercial needs to address human rights issues within their own activities and their business relationships. At the same time they are confronted with a number of challenges, companies are often uncertain of how to avoid complicity in human rights abuse and where the boundaries of their human rights responsibility lie. This session will begin reviewing latest global trends on Business and human rights including the establishment of National Action Plan (NAP) in Europe and Asia, guidelines and resources for businesses, and discuss the way to scale up corporate engagement in this agenda. Through various examples, panellists will showcase their efforts to respect and support human rights and highlight the challenges they face with regards to their human rights policies, processes and initiatives.

- What are the key international and regional legal frameworks that are relevant to businesses and human rights?
- What are the roles can stakeholders such as government, civil society and academia play to support business efforts to respect and support human rights?
- What are the notable examples that support social development and why these efforts are important to respect and support human rights?
