

반부패 (Anti-Corruption) 분과세션

Corruption is one of the greatest obstacles to economic and social development around the world, and business often find challenging to implement effectively the Global Compact's anti-corruption principle. Since the adoption of the UN Convention against Corruption in 2003 and subsequent addition of the 10th Principle in 2004, good progress has been made to address corruption. However, more efforts will be needed to advance this critical agenda. This breakout session will begin reviewing changing anti-corruption culture, policies and procedures in the private sector over the last 10 years, and discuss the way forward with an emphasis on the collective action mechanism. Collective Action has increasingly become one important way for companies to engage with competitors, government, civil society and other key stakeholders and deal with the risks of corruption as well as level the playing field. Through various examples, this session will also demonstrate how Korean companies can effectively engage in collective action efforts.

- What are the key issues that businesses will need to address to tackle corruption challenges?
- Why is the collective action approach increasingly embraced by businesses in addressing corruption challenges?
- What are the roles can stakeholders such as government, civil society, and academia play to support business efforts on anti-corruption?
