On this journey, visitors will also visit a leading global energy management company offering business solutions to achieve energy and engineering efficiency in buildings.


1) Visit to One Tampines Hub

One Tampines Hub (OTH) is Singapore's first-ever integrated community and lifestyle hub that brings together multiple agencies to offer a comprehensive and diverse range of services, programmes and facilities.

This 2.5 million ft², BCA Green Mark Platinum town hub, is projected to reduce energy usage, resulting in an emission reduction of carbon dioxide which contributes to the much-needed effort to reduce global warming.



Designed by residents, for residents, OTH serves as a high-tech garden for the community to enjoy and to experience a cleaner and greener environment. Residents can also make use of the six rooftop swimming pools, kids' playground, and a sports and recreation park with four tennis courts, two futsal courts and one hockey court. They can also use the services of 12 government agencies at the hub's 24-hour Public Service Centre.





2) Visit to Schneider Electric East Asia and Japan HQ

Schneider Electric, one of the leaders in the digital transformation of energy and automation opened its new East Asia & Japan headquarters in Singapore on 29 March 2018.

The 9-storey building was retrofitted at a cost of S\$23 million and is Schneider Electric's first building in East Asia & Japan to use a hybrid electricity power source



powered by solar panels installed onsite and offsite.

Powered by Schneider Electric's own smart building management solutions, it is the first office building to qualify for a BCA Green Mark Platinum Award by the Building and Construction Authority for Existing Non-Residential Building Pilot Version 2017.

The Group also established its first large-scale Innovation Hub in Asia, after Boston and Paris. This hub is a co-innovation platform with world-class facilities, enabling Schneider Electric to develop tailored solutions to optimise energy efficiencies for building, healthcare, data center, oil and gas and utilities segments.



Spanning over 18,500 m² and home to over 1,200 employees, the Innovation Hub bring together software engineers, solution architects and research scientists, who will work on the company's Internet-of-Things (IoT) enabled system architecture and platform, EcoStruxure.

Learning Journey – Strengthening Cyber Security and Business Integrity

This Learning Journey is for visitors to better understand the importance of strengthening its cyber security operations or risk the consequences. Delegates will visit a global leader in cyber security operating one of the world's largest cyber intelligence networks.

On this journey, visitors will also learn about Singapore's Corrupt Practices Investigation Bureau efforts in combatting corruption in Singapore.

1) Visit to Symantec Singapore



Increasingly, we hear of cyber-attacks

against organisations and the devastating consequences of being unprepared for it. In Singapore, lax security at SingHealth was one of the reasons which led to the personal data of 1.5 million people stolen. Therefore, how can businesses protect themselves against such threats?

A global leader in cyber security, Symantec operates one of the world's largest cyber intelligence networks to help companies, governments and individuals secure their most important data. Delegates will learn about the global trends in cyber security and visit a security operations center.

2) Visit to Corrupt Practices Investigation Bureau (CPIB) Reporting & Heritage Centre



Heritage Centre (CRHC) is the latest facility and premises of the Corrupt Practices Investigation Bureau (CPIB) where it houses the Bureau's rich history and key milestones/events and interesting cases with regard to the fight against corruption.



A guided tour at the CRHC will cover the role and functions of CPIB, Singapore's anticorruption strategies, CPIB's experience in combatting corruption and some cases of interest.

Visitors will also get the opportunity to hear oral clips from the Investigation Officers of CPIB sharing their experiences in conducting investigation for some of the high profile cases.
